



ADRED LENOIR

Adred Lenoir, 98, of Clanton, formerly of Bessemer, passed away March 20, 2022. He graduated from Jemison High School. Adred was a farmer before serving in the United States Navy during World War II. He was the last living survivor of the USS Samuel B. Roberts (DE-413). This destroyer sank during the Leyte Gulf Battle, and he survived for 52 hours in the water before rescued. After being discharged from the Navy he moved to Birmingham, Al., where he worked 8 years for Union Supply Company. He then worked for the US Postal Service as a carrier and postal clerk, retiring after 36 years.

Adred was preceded in death by his wife Eunice Lenoir; his parents Thomas Leonard and Electra Childress Lenoir; and brothers Walter Lance Lenoir and Thomas Vaughn Lenoir. He is survived by his son Dr. Allen Adred Lenoir; loved as children Clint and Gianetta Jones; grandchildren Dana Lenoir Woodyatt (Luke), Andrew Lenior (Ai), loved as grandchildren Clinton Blake Jones (Jennifer), Amy Jones Booth (William); great grandchildren Brooklyn Jones, Colten Jones, Miller Booth, Ryker Jones, Asher Jones and Sarah Booth; sister Kathleen Lenoir Wright, Betty Ann Lenoir Franklin, and Sarah Lenoir White; and numerous nieces and nephews.

The visitation will be Wednesday, March 23, 2022, from 10:00 AM until 11:00 AM, at Peoples Chapel Funeral Home. The funeral service will be at 11:00 AM at the Funeral Home, with Rev, Paul Nolen officiating. Burial will follow at

Cedar Hill Cemetery.

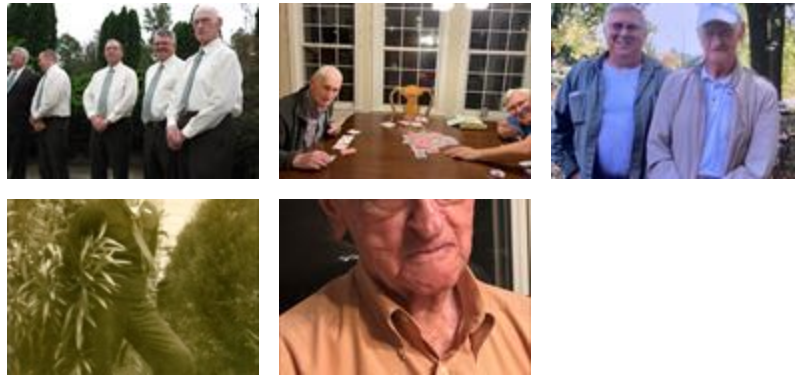
