Alice Faye Bowers Harris, age 83, of Hueytown, Alabama, met her Savior on Wednesday, November 16, 2022, at home. Alice Faye was born in Tarrant, Alabama on October 31, 1939. After graduating from Tarrant High School, she immediately began working for South Central Bell, later BellSouth, and her career spanned forty years. She served as Executive Assistant to many vice presidents with the organization during her tenure. Alice Faye married Jack Harris in 1960, and he affectionately called her his “Buddie,” a nickname she kept the rest of her life. She was a long-time member of North Highlands Baptist Church where she and Jack attended regularly until their health declined.
