Reverend Arnold Lee Bailey went home to be with the Lord on Monday, January 27, 2025. He was 89 years old. Brother Bailey was pastor of Bethel Baptist Church, Abernant Baptist Church, Rockdale Baptist Church and was interim Pastor of Powderly Baptist Church before his retirement in 1995. He was a Veteran of the United States Marine Corps and served in Korea from 1953-54. After his service in Korea, he worked for Winn Dixie Corp managing and co-managing several stores in the Jefferson Country area. Following his retirement, he worked for several years at Hill's grocery store in Pleasant Grove. Brother Bailey received a Bachelors' Degree from Samford University in 1978.

Arnold was preceded in passing by his wife Charlotte Hill Bailey in April of 2019. He is survived by his sons Mr. Gregory Bailey (Karen), of Pelham, and Mr. Barry Bailey (Jean), of Pleasant Grove; two grandchildren Mr. Jacob Bailey (Maya), of Pelham, and Miss Rebekah Bailey of Pleasant Grove; two great-grandchildren, Charlotte Grace and Adrian Olivier Bailey, both of Pelham; two sisters Mrs. Ottie Lou Butatz of San Juan Capistrano, California, and Mrs. Margaret Hilburn of Maytown.
