Dale Sellers, 72, of Alliance, Alabama, passed away on August 7, 2023. He was preceded in death by his parents, Floyd "Bud" and Bobbie Reed Sellers. As a local small business owner, master plumber, gas fitter, and craftsman, Dale often

An avid reader of fiction and science, an animal lover, and bird-watcher, Dale was happiest at home on his farm. A master storyteller, he never missed an opportunity for a lively discussion, and loved discussing philosophy, patriotism, architecture, engineering, nature, and religion.

Particularly fascinated with the night sky and the phases of the moon, he would often ask those visiting the farm, "Have you looked up at the stars and heavens tonight?" He also marveled at the magic of his grandchildren, and would light up every time he saw them. He consistently sought to inspire everyone in his family, particularly his daughters. He would often tell them, "You can do anything you want to do in life."
