Ira Clinton "Clint" Chaney, age 90, of Concord, passed away April 7, 2024.

He married Mary Sue Morgan on August 8, 1955, and was married 61 years until her passing in 2016. Ira served in the US Army and Army Reserve from 1953 until 1961. He was employed by US Steel at the Fairfield Works for 43 years from 1952 to 1996 holding various positions including operations at the seamless pipe mill prior to his retirement.
