D. Jack Baughn, age 93, of Hueytown Al., born November 10, 1924, and passed away January 7, 2018. Jack was a Christian and a former member of Hueytown Church of Christ. Jack retired from Liberty National Life Insurance with several accomplishments, being a leading agent, winning many awards, and later becoming district manager. He joined the U.S. Navy in January 18, 1943, and he served during WWII. He went through Naval Air Gunner School in Oklahoma. Obtained rank of Aviation Ordnanceman First Class. Served as a tailgunner on a Grumman TBC-1C avenger, from Composite Squadron 19 (VC) and Composite Squadron 42 (VC-42), and aboard USS Croatan (CVE-25). His group was responsible for the sinking of 7 German U-Boats. Jack was a loving husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, and a great-great grandfather. He was preceded in death by his daughter Donna Baughn Church, and grandson Larry Kyzer, Jr. He is survived by his wife of 70 years Jean Johnson Baughn; daughter Judi Baughn Theros (Larry); grandsons Michael Todd Theros (Traci), and Jordan Church; granddaughters Eden Sebasty (Ken), Jeanie Wood (Brad), and Lindsey Woodard; 13 great grandchildren; 3 great-great grandchildren; numerous nieces, nephews, and a host of friends.
