John H. Berryhill, 76 of Pleasant Grove, AL, died Friday, October 20, 2017.

Mr. Berryhill was born in Hamilton, Alabama on December 7, 1940 to Bud and Louise Berryhill. A native of Wylam, he graduated Ensley High School and then Mississippi State University with a degree in Industrial Engineering. He completed his education with a Masters in Public and Private Management from Birmingham Southern College. During high school he was active in the Boy Scouts of America, earning the distinction of Eagle Scout.

Commissioned a 1st Lieutenant in the U.S. Air Force, Mr. Berryhill served as an instructor at Lowery AFB in Denver, CO. Following his time in the service, Mr. Berryhill worked for United States Steel, Fairfield Works, for 32 years, serving primarily as a supervisor in the open hearth and Q-Bop.

Mr. Berryhill was married 53 years to his high school sweetheart Sally Marilyn Lewis Berryhill. Together they raised two sons and served tirelessly for Martin Memorial United Methodist Church and later Pleasant Grove United Methodist Church. He was a long-time member of the J.P. Simmons Sunday School class. Survivors include his wife Sally of Pleasant Grove; sons Jonathan (Ellery) and Jason (Crystal), all of Vestavia Hills, Alabama; his grandchildren, John Sawyer, Blakely, Neely and Ben; and brother Joe Berryhill of Pearl, MS.
