Lan Van Le, born June 16, 1950, lost his battle with cancer on Thursday, February 5.

Born in a small town in Vietnam, he & Loan Vo Le, his wife of 51 years, migrated to the United States as refugees in 1975. William T. King sponsored Lan & his family as they transitioned to US citizenship. Lan & his family attended First Presbyterian Church of Trussville where his son Tony & daughter Michelle were baptized. He later served as an elder to the church. Lan Van Le is the embodiment of the American Dream. He and his wife came to America with the clothes on their back and a few items of gold & thrived, building a loving, closeknit family & successful careers. He leveraged his expertise as an Electrical Draftsman while working with IT&T in Vietnam into an Engineering job with Joy Manufacturing early on, and finished his successful 40 year career as lead designer for Southern Company.

Lan is survived by his loving wife Loan Le, son Tony, daughter Michelle, grandchildren Trey & Lana, sisters Phung Le, An Le & Dinh Le, nephews and grand-nephews who followed in his footsteps and migrated to this country. His hard work, determination, positive attitude, desire to succeed and passion for taking care of and celebrating his family leave a lasting legacy that his family will carry on for future generations in his name.
