Larry Fulton Lenoir was born May 18th, 1929 in Bessemer, Alabama. Larry was the only child of Kathleen Ingram Lenoir and Robert Fulton Lenoir. Mr. Lenoir attended Jefferson County Public Schools.

Mr. Lenoir served in the United States Army stationed in Korea with the 8075 Mash Unit.

Following his military service Mr. Lenoir spent 50 years in the furniture business in Birmingham, Alabama.

After his retirement he volunteered at the Family YMCA as a water aerobics instructor and after school bus driver.

Mr. Lenoir was a member of Zamora Shrine Temple where he logged more than 100 trips transporting children and their families to Shrine Hospitals for treatment. Larry obtained his 32nd degree in the Scottish Rite. He was awarded his 50-year pin in 2019. He was also a member of Flint Hill #810 and Fairfield #749 lodges – serving as Worshipful Master of Flint Hill #810.

Mr. Lenoir was preceded in death by his longtime companion Ruth Brewster. He is survived by his only child, Dianne Lenoir Bowler and her husband Michael F. Bowler, III, his only Grandchild, Monica Miller Knight and her husband Stephen T. Knight, and his only Great Grand Child, Kara Grace Knight all of Charleston, SC.
