Christine before passing was the only living Charter Member of the Overton Road Church that was founded in 1946. She served 25 years as the Organizer of Women's Ministries which helped fund the new church and parsonage construction cost by selling homemade fried pies and cakes in the Birmingham area. Working for Louise's Petals and Pans several years as a store manager as well as candy and cake chef. She later became well-known in the community as a wedding cake and petit four caterer in addition to those unforgettable fried pies and candy creations. She had a gorgeous smile that illuminated any place she entered. She never met a stranger as she interacted with the community. Her life was a legacy for all the family to follow. She was a loving mother, grandmother and great grandmother to all. Truly the matriarch of the family she lived what she preached and never tired from serving her Lord and Savior. She loved family get-togethers and never let a person leave her home without eating and taking home food. Truly cooking was her talent, but she also had the talents of playing the guitar, piano and singing in a church quartet.

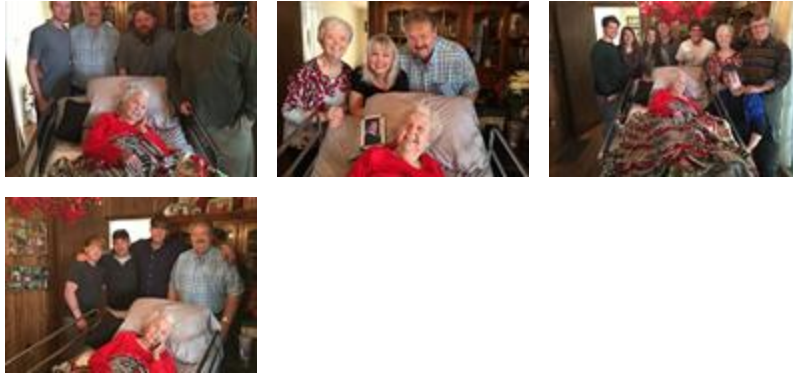

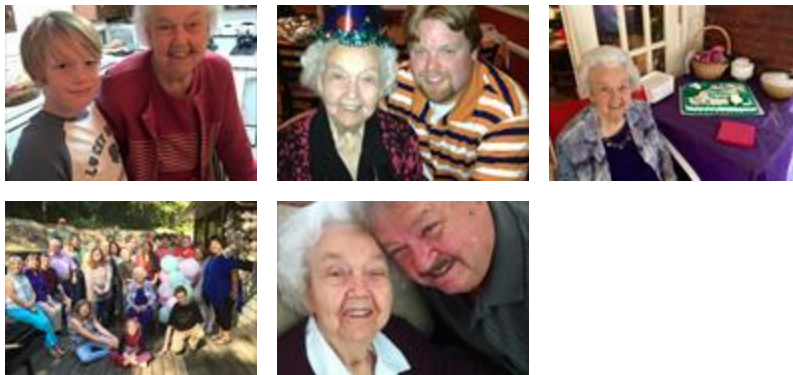
