ROCKETT, LUCILLE FLOWERS, age 93, went home to be with her Lord Monday, August 3, 2009. She spent most of her life in the State of Alabama, her younger days in and around the small town of Sweetwater in Marengo County, and later in the greater Birmingham area. In 1939, she was employed by Tennessee Coal and Iron (later acquired by United States Steel Corporation) where she remained 41 years, until her retirement.
