MOJICA, MIGUEL ANGEL Miguel Angel Mojica, age 74, of Mariara, Carabobo State, Venezuela, died May 13, 2011. He was born and raised in Caguas, Puerto Rico, and served five years in the U.S. Army. In 1958, Mr. Mojica married Alma Juanita Mojica, until her death in 2001. Mr. Mojica served under general appointment for the Church of God of Prophecy in Cleveland, Tennessee since 1974 as a national overseer of Costa Rica, Venezuela and Peru. He was appointed General Presbyter of South America in 1996, until his retirement in 2008. Survivors are his wife of eight years, Rosa Ysabel Gonzales; six children; twelve grandchildren; and two great-grandchildren. Funeral service will be held on May 18, 2011 at 2:00 p.m. at Hopewell Road Church of God of Prophecy, Bessemer, Alabama, with visitation beginning at 12:00 p.m. Burial will be in the adjoining cemetery.
