“ We met at the Oaks on Parkwood on a Sunday afternoon. Once a month, the receptionist (at that time) would play the piano (beautifully) - and I would lead the residents in a singing session of good-old-fashioned red-book favorite hymns.

*Ms. Mittie didn't have to look at the hymnbook, she knew EVERY word of EVERY song we sang. All of them.*

*We bonded that afternoon. From that point on, whenever I passed by her, I/we would hug, squeeze hands and maybe sing something real quick.*

*I work as "PRN" - only when needed or as necessary, so I wasn't there every day. When Covid hit and the residents could no longer sit in the common area, I would stop by her room and spend a few minutes with her whenever I could. Not as often as I would have liked. Her face always lit up when I came in the room.*

*The last visit I had with her was after I got off work on December 8th. We spent a good 20-30 minutes together and sang several old songs. I could hear her little soft-spoken voice, barely audible, whispering the words. All of them. In the Garden, Amazing Grace, I'll Fly Away... That evening will always be a precious memory; as knowing her sweet-sweet spirit and knowing she loved me, will always be a very special, precious memory.*
