He was 66 years old and passed away at home, May 28, 2025, in Pleasant Grove, AL. Raymond graduated in 1977 from Cherokee Vocational High School, Cherokee, AL. After graduation He served in the Army for 3 years, stationed in Germany. After discharge for the Army He served in the Air Force Reserve for 23 years as a medic. In 1984 he was named Airman of the Year. While in the Air Force he attended UAB earning a Bachelor's degree in Science and Mathematics in 1986. In 1988, he attended Herzing University earning a Microsoft Engineering Certificate. After a short stint in Germany as a civilian He returned home to begin a career as a Low Voltage Technician. He started his own company.

He and his wife were active in Pleasant Grove United Methodist Church. He participated in meal preparation for a prison ministry. He also did low voltage work at the Church.
