HENDRIX, SARAH "POLLY" Age 91, of Pleasant Grove, AL went to be with her Lord on January 23, 2011. She graduated from Parrish High School before marrying her husband of 65 years, Sylvester "Jim" Hendrix, who at the time was part of the Post War Brooklyn Dodger AAA organization. In 1947 he turned in his spikes to go to bat for God. She followed him to Furman University and Louisville Seminary before they entered into 60 years of service to the Southern Baptist Church. They served in numerous cities, including Jasper and Ensley, AL; Meridian and Jackson MS before arriving to the last stop in their journey of service at South Park Baptist Church in Birmingham, AL. At South Park, they were among the first of Southern Baptist Churches, who during the times of conflict, helped convert the church to a multi-cultural congregation. They were provided a key to the city of Fairfield for their example of unity and brotherhood. They remained members of South Park until their death. She is survived by one brother, Erskine Courington of Ft. Lauderdale; sister, Jesse Harris of Montgomery; son, James "Jim" Hendrix (Cristina); daughter, Sharon Hendrix Blue; grandchildren, Christina Meadows (Billy), Joseph "Joey" Hendrix, Erin Blue, Jennifer Barnes (Justin); and a great-grandchild, Rachael Hendrix.
